Yijia Lin was born in 1997 in China. She is now a first-year student of Bachelor at The Hanover University of Music. In 2016 she was a prizewinner at The Muechner Klavierpodium International Piano Competition in Munich, where she was awarded Virtuoso Prize and Media Prize.

Subsequently she participated in Euro Music Festival and played in two concerts and in the final concert. Earlier in 2011 at the age of 14 she was honorable mention at The Louisiana International Piano Competition. In 2012 she was one of 14 semi-finalists at ILYM International Piano Competition, but withdrew herself from the competition for health reason.

In the past she studied with Prof. Ling Yuan in China at the middle school attached to Beijing Central Conservatory of Music. During her study in Beijing she received "outstanding student scholarship" every year from the conservatory.

From 2009 to 2010, she appeared weekly on China Central Television Music Channel for a TV program "Music Tells You" as selected student. In May of 2010 she performed Mozart Sonata on China Central Television Music Channel in TV program "Piano Appreciation" as solo pianist. Besides she was enhanced by participating in master-classes given by Beatrice Berthold, Klaus Bäßler, Antonio Di Cristofano, Roland Krüger, Seymour Lipkin, Anna Malikova, Victoria Mushkatkol, Matti Raekallio, Hubert Rutkowski and Tamas Ungar.
